



Expressive Vendor Overview

To protect and preserve the park and prevent excessive commercialism, congestion, and public safety issues, vending of expressive matter is only allowed as follows:

For these purposes, “expressive matter” is created by the vendor including content, such as newspapers, books, or writings; visual art, such as paintings, prints, photography, and sculpture; and the activity of performing.

The following regulations govern the vending of expressive matter within the park.

1. Vendors may only sell or perform at a specifically designated location(s).
2. May only occupy the designated area consistent with the hours of operation.
3. A total of eight (8) are allowed at any one time, and on a first come, first served basis.
4. Expressive vendors may not;
 - a. Touch, lean, or affix any item to the street, park furniture, building, rock, landscape feature, or planting.
 - b. Block any person from using any street, sidewalk, or pathway.
 - c. Sell anything in such a manner that would damage or otherwise injure Town property.
 - d. Place any items for sale on a sidewalk, park path, blanket, or board placed upon such surface or sell items from any motor vehicle.
 - e. Solicit customers verbally.
5. Item display may not:
 - a. Provide less than a six (6) foot wide clear pedestrian path;
 - b. Occupy more than eight (8) linear feet of space parallel to any road, sidewalk, or path;
 - c. Occupy more than three (3) linear feet in depth; or
 - d. Use any areas other than that area immediately beneath the surface of the display stand for storage.
6. Vendors may be relocated or presence limited/prohibited during certain circumstances.
7. In addition to the penalties otherwise provided for under Section 12-4-9, privileges may be suspended or terminated in the event of provision violation(s).
