TOWN OF CAPE ELIZABETH FORT WILLIAMS PARK SITE RENTAL REGULATIONS

- Please have your Permit with you.
- All items must be walked onto public areas.
- All guests must exit the park before closing time (sunset) each day— no exceptions.
- Fort Williams Park is carry in carry out- there are no trash receptacles. All trash must be removed by the renter/user.
- Smoking is prohibited in Fort Williams Park and on the Portland Head Light Parcel- this includes vaping.
- Fort Williams Park is subject to the public drinking laws of the State of Maine and the Town of Cape Elizabeth. No alcoholic beverages may be consumed in conjunction with any approved rental permit.
- Decorations and signs may be used but it is your responsibility to remove them. No
 nails staples or tacks in any table, wood or tree structure. Directional signs must be free
 standing or they will be removed by park staff.
- Tents and canopies are not allowed anywhere inside the park, except at the Picnic Shelter and Ship Cove Platform <u>if given prior permission</u> by the Visitor Services Supervisor (<u>Dominic.Walker@capeelizabeth.org</u>).
- Any picnic tables moved must be placed back in their original locations before leaving.
- All commercial passenger vehicles must use the bus lane in the Central Parking lot, for an additional fee- https://www.capecommunityservices.org/commercial-vehicle-permits/
- Guest parking fees are not included with this permit. Vehicles must park in designated areas only.
- Any violation of these regulations may result in forfeiture of the security deposit.
