TOWN OF CAPE ELIZABETH FORT WILLIAMS PARK CEREMONY REGULATIONS

- Ceremonies and photographs are not permitted on the Portland Head Light Parcel inside the park.
- Fort Williams Park is subject to the public drinking laws of the State of Maine and the Town of Cape Elizabeth. No alcoholic beverages may be consumed in conjunction with any approved ceremony and/or reception.
- Tents/Canopies are not allowed for ceremonies, though arbors may be used.
- Smoking is prohibited in Fort Williams Park and on the Portland Head Light Parcel- this includes vaping.
- Fort Williams Park is carry in carry out- there are no trash receptacles. All trash must be removed by the renter/user.
- All items must be walked onto public areas.
- A limited number of chairs (6-8) may be used for persons with mobility issues.
- Decorations and signs may be used but it is your responsibility to remove them. No nails, staples, or tacks in any table, wood, or tree structure. Directional signs must be free standing or they will be removed by park staff.
- Ceremony locations are public open spaces and there may be other ceremonies, members of the public, including children at, or near any ceremony location in Fort Williams Park. Weddings and large groups must not impede the mobility and enjoyment of other visitors.
- Ceremonies may include, but are not be limited to; wedding ceremonies, commitment celebrations, and renewal of vows.
- All commercial passenger vehicles must use the bus lane in the Central Parking lot, for an additional fee- https://www.capecommunityservices.org/commercial-vehicle-permits/
- Guest parking fees are not included with this permit. Vehicles must park in designated areas only.
