

Parking Guide for School/Camp Trips

Recreation Departments, Non-Profit Summer Camps, and School Field Trips (Private/Public)

- 1. Please call Cape Elizabeth Community Services, (207) 799-2868, to make a reservation.
- 2. <u>Approved</u> groups may unload, park, and pick-up for free in the overflow parking lot, located adjacent to the Children's Garden.
 - a. Access this unpaved parking lot by making the <u>first right turn</u> inside the park.

College Programs and For-Profit Summer Camps

- 1. Please call Cape Elizabeth Community Services, (207) 799-2868, to make a reservation.
- 2. <u>Groups MUST pay bus parking fees</u>. They will unload, park, and pick-up in the central parking lot's bus lane. Payment at the greeter's station near the bus lane <u>via cash/check</u> (no credit cards). See fees below:

General Park Rules

- 1. Park hours are sunrise to sunset.
- 2. The entire Park is Carry-in / Carry-out. Please bring your own trash bags.
- 3. No alcohol or smoking in the Park.
- 4. Tents or "pop up" canopies are not permitted in the park, except in connection to a site reservation (Picnic Shelter and Ship Cove Platform only).
- 5. Large groups must not impede the mobility and enjoyment of other visitors.
- 6. Picnic tables must be returned to their designated locations if moved.
